New Living Translation

Simple version

Don't pray like the other people around you, they pray to please others instead of God. When you pray find a place to be on your own where only God can hear you. God will reward you. Your prayers don't need to be long to get God's attention, and don't repeat words over and over. God knows what you are praying for before you ask.

Pray like this:

Father God in heaven, You're great!
I want You to be in charge here
Please give us what we need

Questions to discuss

After reading the story together, you could discuss these questions as a family:

1. Who do you enjoy talking to? What will you talk about?
2. Why do you think Jesus wants us to call God 'Father'?
3. What kind of things do you think could be better on earth?
4. How can you let God be in charge of your life?

Amen.

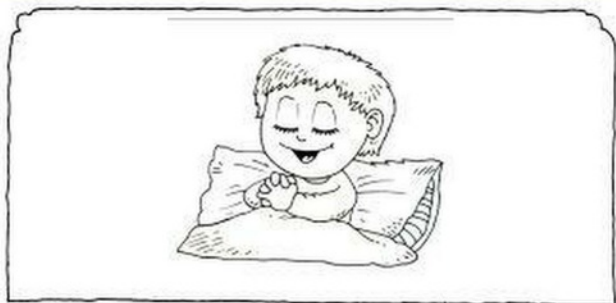

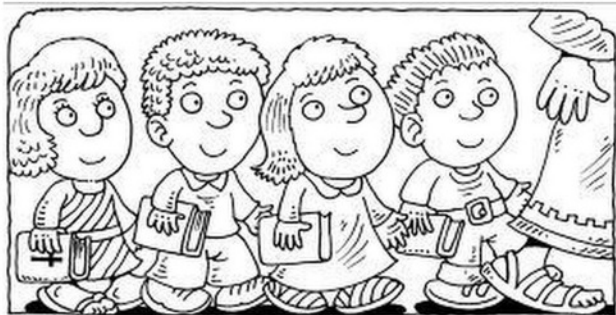

to his father God in heaven.



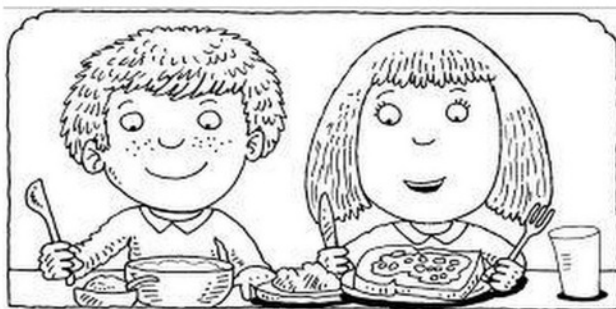
Jesus taught his friends

"Our Father in heaven.



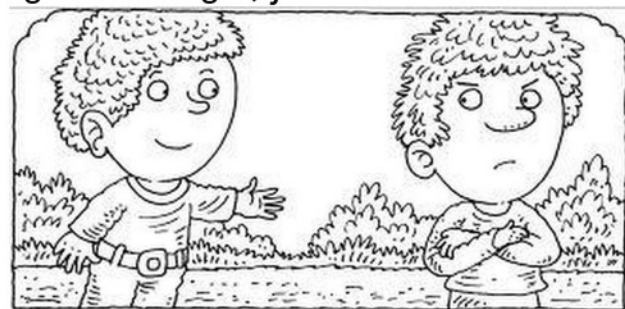
Your name is more important

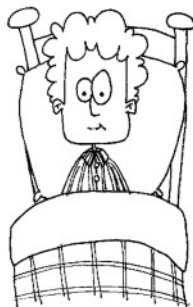

Creative prayer

"Your will be done on earth as it is in heaven."

We want all that is good in your sight to happen here on earth as it happens in heaven.

There are lots of signs that tell us what we should do and how to stay safe. If the sign is within a circle it is an order - we must do it.

If the sign is within a triangle it warns us that there is danger.

What kind of signs do you think God would make to teach us how to live? e.g. love each other, don't fight, take care of my world. Draw some.

When you are finished thinking or while you are drawing the signs, say a simple prayer to God asking for His help to do what He wants you to do.



Thanks for food

In the prayer Jesus taught his disciples, He said:
"Give us enough food to keep us alive for today."

You will need:

- Half a small cup of rice
- A small plastic bag

What to do:

- Put the rice in the small plastic bag and close the bag.
- Hold the bag in your hand. It's not much food is it?
In many countries of the world people and children do not get enough food.
- Think about the food you have had today.
- Thank God for the food you have eaten today - name it all.
- Think of the children the same age as you in the world who have had no food today.
- Ask God to help them find food.



Prayer den

Jesus told his disciples to go to a room in sight, close the door and pray to God, our Father, who is there with us even though we do not see him.

You will need:

- Cushions, blankets, small lights - anything to make a comfortable den.
- Something that helps you think of God - a Bible, a picture, something from nature.

What to do:

- Make a prayer den for yourself using the items in the list.
- When you are finished, sit in your den to talk to God - pray.
- You may want to ...
 - ... thank God,
 - ... or say 'sorry' to God,
 - ... or seek God's help.
- Or you may want to talk to God about something that is on your mind.

Every day items

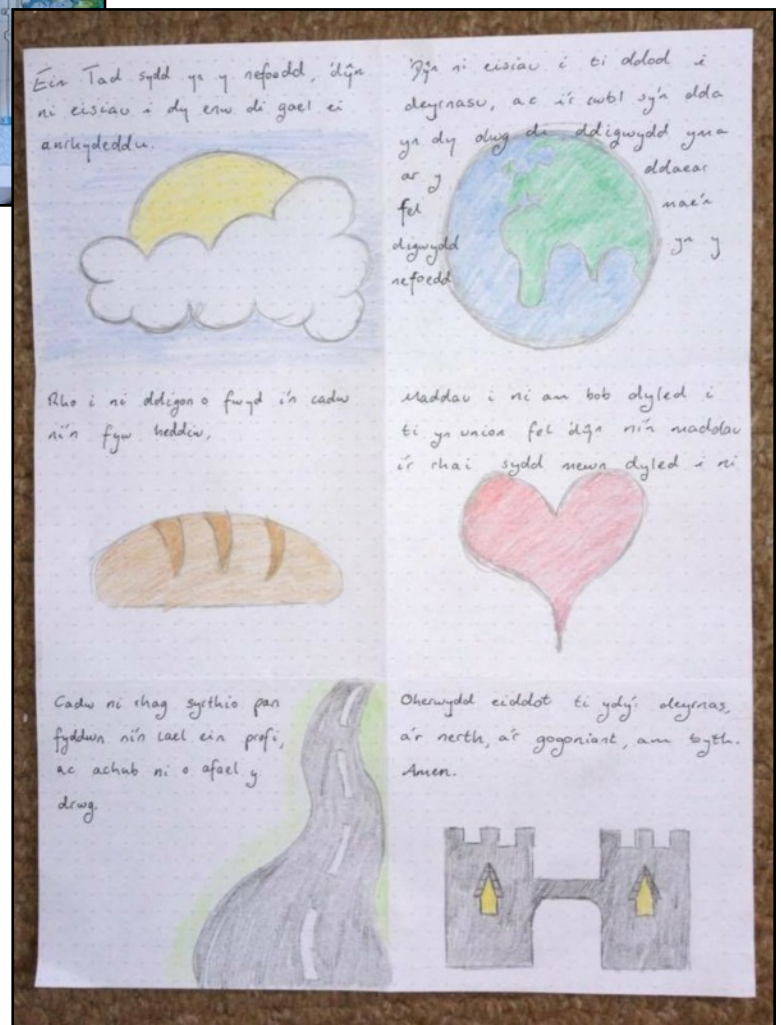
Can you find every day items that represent different parts of the Lord's Prayer?

Poster

Make a poster of the Lord's prayer (here is an example in Welsh).

Craft

Paper Cup Phone



You will need:

2 paper cups,
3 paper clips,
scissors,
thin string or cotton.



1. Carefully open up paper clip.



2. Make a hole in the centre of the base of both cups, using the opened paper clip.



3. Cut about 3 metres of thin string or cotton - anything will do as long as it is not elastic.



4. Thread one end of the thin string through the hole in a cup.



5. Tie a paper clip to the end of the thin string



6. Thread the other end of the thin string through the hole in the second cup & tie a paper clip onto it.



7. Pull the cups apart so that in each cup the paperclip rests flat on the floor of the cup.



8. Your phone is now ready to use!

How to use your Paper Cup Phone....

Take one cup and have someone else take the second cup. Walk away from each other until the string is taut (make sure the string isn't touching anything else). One person talks into the cup while the other puts the cup to their ear and listens, can you hear each other?

Recipe

Make a loaf of bread



Ingredients:

- 400 grams bread flour
- 7 grams yeast
- 8 grams salt
- 240 grams water
- Sesame seeds

Method:

1. Mix together the flour and salt in a bowl then add the yeast.
2. Stir in the water and mix until it becomes a dough.
3. Turn out the dough onto a lightly floured surface and knead for 8-10 minutes.
4. Put the dough back into the bowl, cover it and leave to rest for 1 hour.
5. After 1 hour it will have risen and doubled in size.
6. Turn out the dough and shape it.
7. Put it into a lightly-oiled loaf tin.
8. Sprinkle the top with some sesame seeds.
9. Cover it and leave for 1 hour until it has risen again.
10. Pre-heat your oven to 220 degrees Centigrade.
11. Bake for 25 to 35 minutes until golden brown.
12. Allow to cool before cutting.



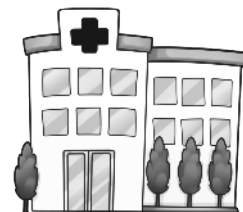

Games



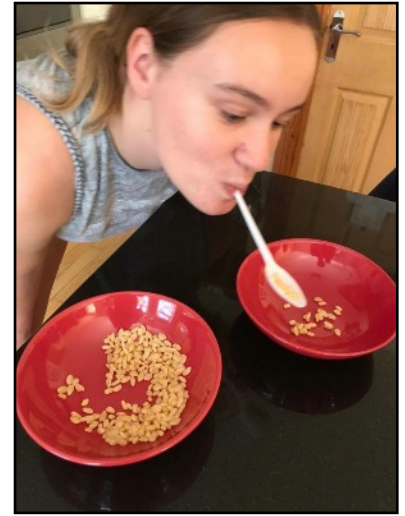
A minute game

You will need:
